



# **APRIL LIBRARY LOOK**

CONCORDIA COMMENTARY—MARK 1:1-8:26 and MARK 8:27-16:20 by James W. Voelz and Christopher W. Mitchell





As our congregation reads through the Gospels this year, we have two volumes of the **Concordia Commentaries** for insight into the **Gospel of Mark**.

Jesus promised a triumphant revelation of himself after the cross, but within <u>Mark</u>, the disciples do not yet see the glorious, risen Christ. They only have his Word. So also, we Christians do not see him and the kingdom fully implemented and manifested now. How difficult it is to be faithful on the basis of the Word alone-- the disciples are testimony to that fact!

If you had been there, it would not have been any easier for you than it is today. The evidence you have is what the disciples and the women had on that Easter morning: the promise of His Word, a Word that is ever sure.

The second and final commentary on the <u>Gospel of Mark</u>, covering verses 8:27-16:20, details the revelation of who the Christ is, the fate of the revealed Christ played out, His appearances to His disciples, the sending of the apostles, and Christ's ascension. The editors conclude with textual notes and commentary on the final twelve verses.
