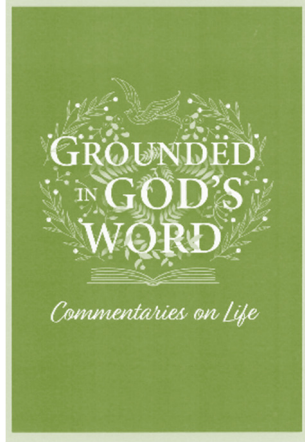

#### **Grounded in God's Word: Commentaries on Life**
