Since 2019, overall enrollment at Lutheran schools in the St. Louis area has increased by 19%. Our own school, Word of Life has also seen a trend in increased enrollment growing from approximately 175 students in 2019 to 224 students in 2024. There will soon be a sign up board in the lobby for tables. \$20 per person, 8 people per table.

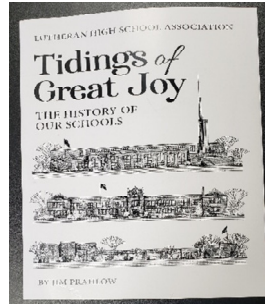
