CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

FALL CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE Recently, at the church facility, the lighting in the chancel was installed and the vent covers in the sanctuary were cleaned, powder coated, and put back on the walls. The ceiling in the narthex was cleaned and new lighting was installed. Additional updates will include cleaning and replacing the outside of the stained glass window over the altar and putting refurbished handles on the Eichelberger entrance doors. The light fixtures at the doors on the Donovan side of church have been stripped of their old paint and will be rehung after they have been refurbished and powder coated. A hard surface flooring will be laid in the chancel. Other projects still on the horizon: baseboard installation, new carpeting, pew refinishing, and additional work in the narthex.

Word of Life now has a functional HVAC system and the boiler has been removed! The playground has been resealed and restriped. Attractive energy-efficient windows have been installed, and all the windows, including the windows on the interior classroom doors, have black-out shades hung. Some of the classroom doors have been stripped, sanded and restained. The computer system between the church and the school is now linked with high-speed fiber optics. A new card access system to control the access to the school and the church has been installed. Coming in November: the windows along the playground will be replaced.

Four classrooms for grade K - 3 plus the office have been remodeled. There is new furniture for these classrooms as well. These expenses have been funded entirely by contributions over and above the monies pledged and allocated to the school through the "Sharing Christ's Love, Today and Tomorrow" Capital Campaign.

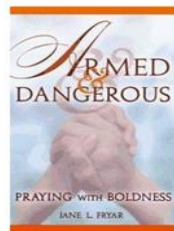
